# **HOW SHOULD WE THEN LIVE?**

#### INTRODUCTION

We live in a world that has its own priorities, many of which clash with the priorities of those who love and follow Jesus. Colossians 3:12-14 contains a beautiful description of qualities a follower of Christ exhibits. At the end of the list, believers are told to "put on love". Our actions and reactions show the world where our priorities are.

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. Share with the group your favorite sports team. To what extremes have you gone to show your support for your team?
- 2. Read Colossians 3:12-14. Do you *feel* "chosen", "holy", and "dearly loved" by God? Why or why not? Regardless of how you *feel*, how can you live in the **reality** of these descriptions?
- 3. List the five character qualities with which Paul says we are to "clothe ourselves". Which of these qualities comes most naturally to you in our current culture? Which is the most counter-cultural?
- 4. There are numerous Scriptures that discuss putting on clothing. Read the following passages, list what goes on (and/or comes off), and discuss with your group which passage impacts you the most.
